

Alice Weston Broadcast Journalism Scholarship Spring 2012

Lorain County Community College is proud to announce the availability of the **Alice Weston Broadcast Journalism Scholarship**. This award is intended to support part-time or fulltime LCCC/UP students pursuing a career in broadcast journalism.



Alice Weston was a pioneer in television broadcasting and was in the profession for over 50 years. She worked for WKYC, WUAB, and WEWS, channels 3, 43 and 5 respectively during her career. She also was one of the first announcers for Elyria's, WEOL/930 and its FM sister, "The Wave" 107.3 stations. In television, she started with a cooking show in 1948 and ended as a seniors reporter in 1996 at the age of 86. Alice was a friend to Lorain County Community College in that she served as Chair of the Citizens for LCCC Committee and advocated for the creation of the University Partnership. She also gave much time to students as well by serving as a mentor for LCCC students majoring in broadcast communications.
