



2011-2012 LCCC International and Study Abroad Scholarship

The Lorain County Community College International and Study Abroad Scholarship is a privately funded award intended to help individuals interested in public diplomacy, foreign language development, cultural enrichment and international understanding. Scholarships will be awarded to students participating in an approved LCCC Study Abroad Program or to international students from the college's overseas partner institutions attending LCCC for the first time.

Scholarships will be applied to the student's cost of education and will be paid directly to the higher educational institution the student is attending. The scholarship can be used to help pay for tuition, books, and other educational expenses. Scholarships will have a minimum value of \$1,000 per academic year and are not renewable.

Eligibility Criteria for Study Abroad Students

- ◆ Be a current LCCC student in at least the second semester and be working towards a degree.
- ◆ Must participate in a Study Abroad Program in one of LCCC's partner institutions of higher learning and be approved by the LCCC International Initiatives Office. Currently, LCCC has partnerships with the following institutions:
 - ◆ CHINA: Changsha University and Hunan University of International Economics in Changsha
 - ◆ FRANCE: Université de Savoie – GACO Branch, Chambéry
 - ◆ GERMANY: Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange for Young Professionals
 - ◆ GREECE: American College of Thessaloniki
 - ◆ ITALY: Kent State University in Florence
 - ◆ SOUTH KOREA: Yeungjin College
 - ◆ TAIWAN: Ching Kuo Institute of Management and Health and Meiho Institute of Technology
 - ◆ THAILAND: Rangsit University in Bangkok
- ◆ Must have a minimum 3.0 LCCC cumulative GPA required.
- ◆ Must complete the 2011-2012 Free Application for Federal Study Aid (FAFSA) and demonstrate financial need. Students may complete the FAFSA on-line at www.fafsa.gov.

Eligibility Criteria for International Students

- ◆ Must be a new, entering student at Lorain County Community College FROM ONE OF THE COLLEGE'S FOREIGN PARTNER SCHOOLS (no previous coursework completed at LCCC).
- ◆ Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA or equivalent from the student's home school. Official transcripts must be sent to Lorain County Community College.
