The Lorain County Community College **Power of Pi** Scholarship Selection Committee is pleased to announce funding for the seventh annual Power of Pi Scholarship to be awarded in the fall of 2012. The scholarship has been made possible by individual donors and the profits from the Kaiden Irrational Run, which was founded to honor Professor Emeritus, Robert Kaiden.

The scholarship will be awarded annually to one student who has successfully completed (or is currently attending and making successful progress towards the completion of) at least one math course through the Academic Foundations division. The scholarship will be a one time award of \$500.
