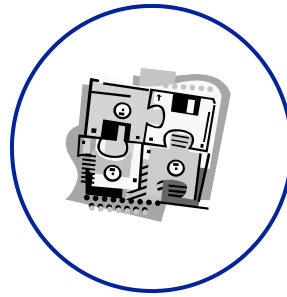

The LCCC Foundation is pleased to announce funding for **full tuition** scholarships for students enrolled in the University of Toledo Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) program through the University Partnership at LCCC. This scholarship has an approximate value of \$20,000 for the entire CSE program. At the discretion of the Selection Committee, partial scholarships may also be awarded. The priority date for scholarship application is **January 31, 2012**.

Completed applications received by January 31, 2012 will receive full consideration. Applications will continue to be accepted through **June 30, 2012** on a funds available basis. Selection is based on the completed scholarship application, academic performance, letters of recommendation, and essays. Scholarship finalists may be invited to personally interview with the University Partnership CSE Scholarship Selection Committee.

Decisions of the Selection Committee will be final.

Qualifications for High School Graduates:

- 3.21 cumulative GPA and 24 composite ACT
OR
- 3.00 cumulative GPA and 25 composite ACT
AND
- 4 years of high school math (including Trigonometry)
- Ability to enroll in Calculus at LCCC (applicants will be tested for calculus readiness)

Qualifications for Current College Students**

- NEW to the CSE program (no previous CSE coursework)
- 3.0 minimum cumulative college GPA, with a minimum of 16 semester hours completed
AND
- "B" or better in Calculus I (LCCC MTHM 181 or equivalent)
OR
- "B" or better in General Chemistry (LCCC CHMY 171 or equivalent)

**Decisions for current college students will be made after spring grades are received.
