

Constitution of ALL COMBATIVE FORMS *Organization*

Article I

The name of this organization is **ALL COMBATIVE FORMS** or **ACF**.

Article II

The goal of the ACF is to promote physical fitness, knowledge of all style and forms of martial arts, and to develop and share skills to help each individual become more disciplined physically and mentally. The ACF promotes the art of expressing the human body through combative form.

Article III

Membership is open to all students attending Lorain County Community College. To attain membership, applicants must fill out a medical history form, form of intent, and membership application.

Article IV

Formal meetings are to be held every Friday. Additional meetings, such as special activities or rescheduled meetings, may be called by the President and Vice President.

Article V

Advisors are to preside over all financial transactions for budgeting of the ACF. Advisors are to be present at all special activities and events.

Article VI

Section 1. President

President of the ACF is to be present at all ACF functions, special meetings, and events. President supervises all activities of treasurer and event coordinators. President may be removed from office by a majority rule.

Section 2. Vice President

Vice President is second in command of ACF. Vice President is to be at all meetings, special meetings, and events. When President is unable to attend a meeting, Vice President assumes all responsibilities of the President. Vice President may be removed by a majority vote.

Section 3. Event Coordinators

Event coordinators are to set up all special events, where, when, and work in conjunction with treasurer for funding. All events must go through a review by the President and Vice President. Event Coordinators may be removed from office by the decision of the president only.

Section 4. Treasurer

Treasurer is responsible for all funding, sponsorship, and admission costs at events (when applicable). All transactions must be signed by Advisor and President. Treasurer may be removed from office by a majority rule of all officers.

Article VII

Elections are held when an officer steps down or is removed. Officers may be elected only by Active Members and current officers by a two-thirds vote.

Article VIII

Amendments to the Constitution of ALL COMBATIVE FORMS Organization must be approved by a two-thirds vote of Active Members.

Article IX

Section 1. Activities and Events

The activities and events of the ACF include sparring and callisthenic training.

Section 2. Weekly Meeting

The weekly meeting is a standard group sparring activity. It is preceded by a group warm-up, followed by instruction for newcomers, and sparring for experienced members.

The weekly meetings are opportunities to help each other as martial artists to improve techniques and skills, as well as physical fitness.

Section 3. Special Activities

Special Activities include anything outside of the regular weekly meetings. This may include extra sparring sessions, group outings, discussions, and guest speakers.

Section 4. Events

At the end of each semester, there will be a Tournament to judge the physical and mental progress of the participants. There will be pre-Tournaments for selected members, to give everyone an idea of how the matches are judged and scored, and prepare for the final Tournament. The Tournament represents the Final Exam, whereas the pre-Tournaments represent quizzes and tests.

Article X

Disciplinary action includes expulsion from the ACF, suspension from the ACF, and possible disciplinary action by Lorain County Community College.

Behavior which will result in disciplinary action includes but is not limited to:

1. Unsportsmanlike attitude or behavior
2. Drug or steroid use
3. Violation of sparring event rules and policy
4. Violation of College Campus rules
