Adopting Vision 2020

Whereas, Lorain County Community College (the College) is firmly committed to meeting the needs and aspirations of the community it serves; and

Whereas, the College, following a comprehensive stakeholder engagement process, adopted the College's active strategic plan, Vision 2.0, in January 2013; and

Whereas, much progress toward fulfilling Vision 2.0 has been achieved with success, there was also a broad recognition that fundamental changes are developing that would challenge the College to refresh its current plan under the new, emerging environment; and

Whereas, the College launched a nine-month refresh process designed to ensure alignment of its strategic vision in order to remain competitive and relevant in the changing environment; and

Whereas, the College assembled a 100-member Vision 2.0 Refresh Council (Council) comprised of equal community and College representatives to review regional, state, national and global trends, while digging deep to understand Lorain County Community College's core values and purpose in service to our community; and

Whereas, this Council refined the core values for Lorain County Community College to clearly support the unique purpose of the institution; and

Whereas, the Council, through this process, established a bold, inspirational vision for what will be achieved by living out the College's core values and purpose; and

Whereas, the Council adopted three bold priorities with 17 specific initiatives for action to drive our community and college toward this vision; and

Whereas, the District Board of Trustees has been deeply involved throughout this effort, affirming the engagement process and outcomes; and

Whereas, the District Board of Trustees has deep appreciation for the volunteer efforts of the Council along with hundreds of faculty, staff and students who added to the plan's development through group conversations, forums and online surveys; and

Whereas, the District Board of Trustees concurs with the components of the refreshed Vision 2.0 strategic plan, now presented as Vision 2020 to guide the institution's efforts for the next three to five years.

Now therefore, be it resolved, the Lorain County Community College District Board of Trustees enthusiastically adopts Vision 2020 as Lorain County Community College's refreshed strategic vision and furthermore extends deep appreciation to members of the Vision Council and campus community for their dedication of time, talent and expertise.
