WOMEN'S BASKETBALL - - The Women's Basketball team was led by Ronnette Rahmon-Sumlin (North Olmsted) over their last three contests, averaging a double-double for the Commodores. Rahmon-Sumlin finished the two-week period with 43 points (14.3 PPG) and 38 rebounds (12.6 RPG), along with seven assists and six steals. Several other players averaged double-digit points, as LCCC capped off the stretch with a huge 98-42 win over OCCAC Conference foe, Hocking College. The win puts the Commodores one victory away from tying the second-best season win total in school history, as they stand 9-11 on the season.

Other top contributors during the 1-2 span, were Tyeisha Sain (Bedford) 13 PPG/5.3 RBG, Marquita Thompson (Cleveland/John Marshall) 11.7 PPG/7.7 RPG, Hannah Oehlstrom (Avon Lake) 11.7 PPG/7.7 RPG, and Armani Atrice (Peninsula/Woodridge) 10 PPG/9 RBG. Oehlstrom led the team with 13 assists over the three games. LCCC suffered a 90-68 road loss to Columbus State, a 71-58 defeat to a tough Lakeland CC team, and the away contest against Sinclair State was rescheduled due to weather with a make-up date of February 10, 2019.

MEN'S BASKETBALL - - The Commodore Men's team finished off the two-week period with a big 89-74 home win against Hocking College, to improve their overall record to 11-9 on the year. The team was without the services of Thomas Hronis (North Ridgeville) in a 87-66 loss on the road to Columbus State, then battled always-tough Division II opponent, Lakeland CC at home. Despite putting up 97 points, they fell to the Lakers by a score of 114-97.

Five players averaged double-digit points over the three contests, with Justin Newman (Cincinnati/Robert A. Taft) and Jovon Jones (Elyria/F.B.C.S.), leading the way. Newman led all players with a combined 54 points for an 18 PPG average, while Jones added 51 points (17 PPG) and 20 rebounds (6.7 RPG) to lead LCCC in that category. Patrick McNeal (Cleveland/John Marshall), Andrew Nelson (Strongsville), and Hronis were the other players with double-digit averages. David Sedeno Martel (Malaga, Spain/ES Vega de Mijas) had a perfect outing against Hocking, shooting 5-5 from the field and 2-2 at the line, to finish with 12 points in just six minutes of play for the Commodores.
