

Lorain County Community College announces the LCCC GED, High School Equivalency and 22 Plus Adult Diploma Scholarship Spring Semester 2019

OVERVIEW

The purpose of the **LCCC GED, High School Equivalency and 22 Plus Adult Diploma Scholarship** is to encourage successful completers to continue their education by enrolling at Lorain County Community College soon after successfully passing the GED or other HSE test or earning their high school diploma through the **22 Plus Program**.

APPLICANT AND RECIPIENT CRITERIA

Successful applicants must fully complete the application by the deadline date and meeting the following criteria:

- Must be a recent recipient of a GED, High School Equivalency or the 22 Plus Adult Diploma through one of the local programs.
- Must enroll at LCCC within 18 months from the date of receiving your credentials.
- Must be enrolled in no less than three (3) credit hours per semester in a program leading to a degree or certificate by the application due date.
- Must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 in order to maintain scholarship funding.
