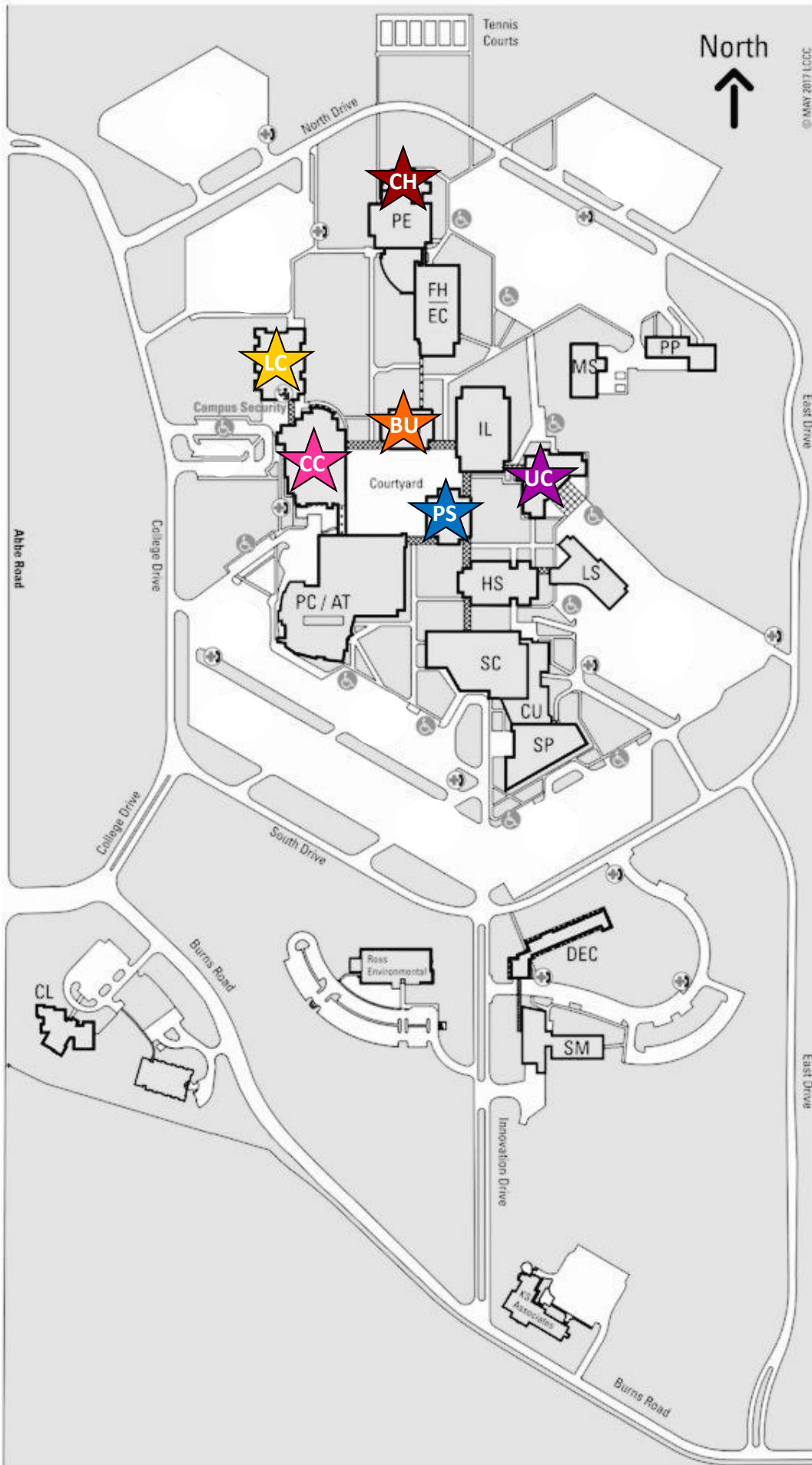

### Children's Learning Center

- **Childcare** — Program is designed for children 18 months to 12 years old (school age summer only) and provides optimal settings for learning and play. Registration is made by semester. Open registration begins the first week of credit registration.

### The Bass Library/Community Resource Center

- **Counseling Services**— Provides crisis intervention services for any student, faculty member or staff member with licensed counselors and social workers.
- **Career Services** — Helps you to identify the career that best fits your goals and interests and connects you to paid internships and other valuable experience before you graduate. When you near graduation, we are here to prepare you for your job search to help you land your dream job.
- **Enrollment Services** — Helps give you the steps you need to apply, register and get ready for your classes.
- **Financial Services** — Can help with any questions about tuition as well as aid.
- **E-Learning** — Extension of face-to-face tutoring offered through the tutoring center. Provides free, professional, online tutoring in areas of writing, math, accounting, biology and chemistry.
- **Library** — Designed to help the campus community and the general public find the information and resources they need in order to be informed and succeed with their studies.
- **SOGE** — Provides advocacy, education, and support services for LCCC's Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ+) community and their Allies.

### Business Building

- **Care Center** — Caring Advocates for Recovery Education (CARE) provides free services to students dealing with addiction.
- **Women's Link** — Women and men can get free and confidential help with personal and academic concerns, such as counseling, crisis intervention, legal services, housing services and short-term emergency loans.
- **Emergency Aid** — Offers small, one-time emergency grants for students.
- **WE3** — Community collaborative focused on helping hard-working single moms increase their earning capacity to become and remain economically secure and self-sufficient.

### College Center

- **Aspire** — Provides free services for individuals who needs assistance by acquiring the skills needed to be successful in a post-secondary education, training and employment; for example GED and English as a Second Language.
- **Commodore Cupboard** — Provides emergency food assistance to community members that meet income-eligibility guidelines.
- **Accessibility Services** — Supports students with disabilities that include physical mobility, health, psychiatric conditions, sensory limitations and learning disabilities.
- **Ride and Share Program** — Helps connect riders and drivers who need transportation to and from LCCC's Main Campus and Learning Centers and an opportunity to share costs.
- **Student Life** — Provides opportunities that enhance the academic experience by engaging students in leadership and fellowship activities while promoting civic interaction and service to the campus community.
- **Tutoring Center** — Provides personalized academic support services to currently enrolled students with resources and tutoring.
