Bachelor of Science in Applied Science-Long-Term Care Administration

As health care needs continue to rise, especially those for the growing elderly population, so does the need for long term care administrators. Long term care administrators manage the daily activities of such residential facilities as nursing homes and retirement communities. They perform tasks ranging from supervising staff and overseeing medical attention to marketing and public relations. Mature, responsible students with strong leadership skills and a desire to work with the elderly would be well-suited for the long term care administration program at Youngstown State University.

Employment Opportunities

Licensed graduates of the long term care administration program at Youngstown State University are eligible to become assistant administrators whose starting salaries are typically in the \$24,000 to \$35,000 range. With commensurate experience, assistant administrators are eligible to become directors whose salaries are often \$60,000 plus.

Degree Options

The primary focus of the long term care administration program at Youngstown State University is to prepare students to become specialized, self-critical, accountable, licensed administrators in nursing and convalescent homes, retirement communities and related healthcare industries.

Graduates receive a Bachelor of Science in Applied Science in long term care administration and are eligible to then work with the State of Ohio to enter the Core of Knowledge and Administrator in Training to work toward licensure as a nursing home administrator.

Students must complete all required coursework for the University and major and have an overall GPA of 2.25, a "C" or better in all courses in the major, 1000 hours in an approved administrator-in-training internship, 48 hours of upper division courses, and 124 hours of coursework overall.
