Successful completion of program application, group admissions interview, transcript review, letter of recommendation

A total of 120 semester hours is required for the Bachelor of Social Work Degree. Students will complete a total of 75 credits through LCCC and 45 credits through YSU. This program will fulfill requirements for an Associate of Arts Degree. See LCCC Advisor for assistance in applying prior coursework, such as the Human Services AAS, to this degree.
