Notes:

- Student must earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours for graduation.
- University and College core requirements must be completed and upper division requirements include the completion of 39 hours at the 3000-4000 level.
- The [University Studies degree](#) differs from other academic programs in that it is built around the goals and interests of the individual student and the specific number of credit hours the student needs for graduation. Each UNIV degree must contain an interdisciplinary focus area of at least 18 hours, with classes from two or more departments, but no more than six classes from one department or more than 30 hours from the College of Business and Innovation.
- A senior capstone course is required in the final semester of study.

- Minors may be incorporated into the degree plan and the student has an option of including a four credit hour internship or field experience in the degree plan.
- All programs are approved as Bachelor of Arts but there is criteria to pursue a Bachelor of Science if desired.
- Any modality of classes are acceptable and Prior Learning Assessment may be utilized. The student has the ability to earn their degree 100% online.
